Weekly Bible Reading: Psalms 22


WORSHIP TOPIC 05:


WORSHIP TOPIC 05:


WORSHIP TOPIC 05:

WORSHIP TOPIC 04:

TWENTY-FOUR HOURS A DAY, SEVEN DAYS A WEEK

The Tabernacle of David marked a revolutionary change from those systems that separated God from the people. The great significance of the Tabernacle of David lies in the fact that the ark is the very presence of God. The people were taught by David to worship God with praise, thanksgiving, and rejoicing, twenty-four hours a day, seven days a week.

1 Chronicles 25:7 Along with their rela-tives—all of them trained and skilled in music for the Lord—they numbered 288.

WORSHIP TOPIC 05:

PATTERN OF WORSHIP

David as a prophet introduced us to the heavenly pattern of worship. The Tabernacle and its function were prophetic. It was a model of life in which God continually commanded, ruled, and ministered to Israel through their continual worship.

Hebrews 13:15 Through Jesus, therefore, let us continually offer to God a sacrifice of praise—the fruit of lips that openly profess his name.
